INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE

7-4-2 *Amendments to the International Fuel Gas Code*

7-4-1: INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE ADOPTED:

- (A) International Fuel Gas Code Adopted: The International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, published by the International Code Council, Inc., is hereby adopted as an official code of the City, except the portions deleted, modified or amended by the provisions of this chapter.
- (B) Code on File: One (1) copy of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, shall be retained by the City Clerk for use and examination by the public. (Ord. 110, 12-19-06)

7-4-2: AMENDMENTS TO THE INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE:

- (A) Section 103.2 of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, shall be amended to read as follows:

103.2 Appointment. The code official shall be appointed by the chief appointing authority of the jurisdiction.

- (B) Section 109.1 of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, shall be amended to read as follows:

109.1 Application for appeal. A person shall have the right to appeal a decision of the code official to the board of appeals. An application for appeal shall be based on a claim that the true intent of this code or the rules legally adopted thereunder have been incorrectly interpreted. The application shall be filed on a form obtained from the code official within 20 days after the notice was served.

- (C) Section 505.1.1 of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, shall be amended to add an exception as follows:

505.1.1 Exception. An interlock between the cooking appliance and the exhaust hood system shall not be required for appliances that are of the manually operated type and are factory equipped with standing pilot burner ignition systems.

- (D) Section 621.4 of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, shall be amended to read as follows:

621.4 Prohibited locations. Unvented room heaters shall not be installed within occupancies in Use Groups A, B, E, I, M and R. The location of unvented room heaters shall also comply with Section 303.3.

- (E) Sections 620.2 and 620.7 of the International Fuel Gas Code, 2003 Edition, are hereby deleted. (Ord. 110, 12-19-06)
